RURAL HEALTH IN THE NEWS

[SAMHSA Rural Opioid Technical Assistance Grants – June 7.](#) The Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMSHA) will make 11 awards of up to \$550,000 each to develop and disseminate training and technical assistance for rural communities to address opioid issues affecting these communities. It is expected that grantees will facilitate the identification of model programs, develop and update materials related to the prevention, treatment and recovery activities for opioid use disorder (OUD), and ensure that high-quality training is provided.

[USDA Rural Community Development Initiative – June 5.](#) The U.S. Department of Agriculture will make 25 awards of up to \$250,000 each for projects related to housing, community facilities, and community and economic development in rural areas. Eligible applicants are local governments, nonprofit community-based housing and development organizations, federally-recognized tribal governments, and qualified private organizations located in towns of 50,000 residents or less. Points will be added to applications with projects that address substance use disorder in high-risk communities.
